- Method 1: By Direct Debit. On the webpage: stradfas.org.uk/Join Us/**
there is a click-through link to our STRADFAS form that you can fill in. (NB 'Gocardless' is the Direct Debit link to our bank). **If two are joining, each needs to complete a Direct Debit** – the amount cannot be changed to twice the membership fee.
- Method 2: By BACS** (online bank payment of £30 pp): **Quote your name on the payment line** and pay to **STRADFAS; Sort code 30-96-26; Account no. 15077760.**
- Method 3: By card machine at a Lecture**
- Method 4: By cheque for £30.00 per person, made out to STRADFAS, signed and dated**, and posted in an envelope to the address above (no SAE required) – or bring to a lecture. Please **do not glue or staple cheques** to the form as they tear when separating, and the Bank will reject them.
